AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in other required equipment, further providing for
3 visual signals on authorized vehicles.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 4572(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania <--
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 SECTION 1. SECTION 4572 OF TITLE 75 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA <--
9 CONSOLIDATED STATUTES IS AMENDED BY ADDING A SUBSECTION TO READ:

10 § 4572. Visual signals on authorized vehicles.

12 (b) Flashing or revolving yellow lights. Vehicles <--
13 authorized pursuant to the provisions of sections 6106 (relating
14 to designation of emergency vehicles by Pennsylvania State
15 Police) and 6107 (relating to designation of authorized vehicles
16 by department), school vehicles, tow trucks and vehicles used
17 for snow removal may be equipped with one or more flashing or

1 ~~revolving yellow lights. The manner in which the light or lights~~
2 ~~shall be displayed and the intensity shall be determined by~~
3 ~~regulation of the department.~~

4 (B.1) YELLOW FLASHING OR REVOLVING LIGHTS ON SCHOOL <--
5 VEHICLES.--SCHOOL VEHICLES MAY BE EQUIPPED WITH A PERMANENTLY
6 AFFIXED OR REMOVABLE YELLOW FLASHING OR REVOLVING LIGHT, AS
7 DETERMINED BY REGULATION OF THE DEPARTMENT. THE LIGHT SHALL ONLY
8 BE ACTIVATED WHEN THE VEHICLE IS PREPARING TO STOP AND STOPPED
9 ON A HIGHWAY TO LOAD AND UNLOAD STUDENTS.

11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
