## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in professional employees, further 5 providing for definitions and providing for school social 6 7 workers. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 1101(1) of the act of March 10, 1949 11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 12 amended to read: 13 Section 1101. Definitions. -- As used in this article, 14 The term "professional employe" shall include those who are certificated as teachers, supervisors, supervising 15 principals, principals, assistant principals, vice-principals, 16 17 directors of vocational education, dental hygienists, visiting 18 teachers, home and school visitors, school social workers, 19 school counselors, child nutrition program specialists, school

librarians, school secretaries the selection of whom is on the

- 4 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 5 Section 1107.1. School Social Workers. -- (a) A school entity
- 6 that employs a school social worker must employ an individual
- 7 who holds an educational specialist certificate for school\_
- 8 social worker issued by the Department of Education.
- 9 (b) The requirements of subsection (a) shall not apply when
- 10 the individual:
- 11 (1) meets the exception for a school social worker as set
- 12 forth in section 20 of the act of July 9, 1987 (P.L.220, No.39),
- 13 known as the "Social Workers, Marriage and Family Therapists and
- 14 Professional Counselors Act"; or
- 15 (2) is employed as or performing the duties of a school
- 16 <u>social worker in a school entity in this Commonwealth and holds</u>
- 17 either a social worker license issued by the Department of State
- 18 or another certificate issued by the Department of Education
- 19 prior to the development of an educational specialist
- 20 <u>certificate for school social worker by the Department of</u>
- 21 Education.
- 22 (c) The Department of Education shall develop an educational
- 23 <u>specialist certificate for school social worker no later than</u>
- 24 sixty (60) days after the effective date of this section.
- 25 (d) For the purposes of this section, the term "school"
- 26 <a href="entity" shall mean any public school district">entity</a>" shall mean any public school district, intermediate
- 27 unit, charter school, cyber charter school, regional charter
- 28 <u>school or area vocational-technical school.</u>
- 29 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
