AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in vocational education, providing
- for a workforce development program clearinghouse.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 1842.1. Workforce Development Program</u>
- 13 Clearinghouse. -- (a) No later than January 1, 2020, the
- 14 Department of Education shall, in consultation with the
- 15 Department of Labor and Industry, conduct an inventory to
- 16 <u>determine the number and types of workforce development programs</u>
- 17 offered at secondary and postsecondary institutions. The
- 18 <u>Department of Education may</u>, in consultation with the <u>Department</u>
- 19 of Labor and Industry, compile a clearinghouse of model programs

- 1 discovered during the inventory. The Department of Education
- 2 and the Department of Labor and Industry shall encourage the use
- 3 of the model programs, which may include prioritizing available
- 4 grant funding for applicants seeking funds to establish
- 5 workforce development programs that are modeled after the
- 6 programs included in the inventory, by secondary career and
- 7 technical education programs, postsecondary programs and
- 8 <u>business and industry to:</u>
- 9 (1) expand existing programs into areas of this Commonwealth
- 10 where there is a need; and
- 11 (2) foster business-education partnerships.
- 12 (b) The Department of Education shall report its findings
- 13 and actions under subsection (a) to the chairman and minority
- 14 <u>chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate, the</u>
- 15 <u>chairman and minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee</u>
- 16 of the House of Representatives, the chairman and minority
- 17 chairman of the Education Committee of the Senate and the
- 18 chairman and minority chairman of the Education Committee of the
- 19 House of Representatives, no later than June 30, 2020.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
