AN ACT

- 1 Providing for health insurance coverage requirements for stage 2 four, advanced metastatic cancer.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Fair Access
- 7 to Cancer Treatment Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Associated condition." A serious cancer related condition <--
- 13 that, in the judgment of the health care practitioner, is caused
- 14 by the cancer or cancer treatment and which further jeopardizes-
- 15 the health of a patient if left untreated.
- 16 "Enrollee." Any policyholder, subscriber, covered person or

- 1 other individual who is entitled to receive health care services
- 2 under a health insurance policy.
- 3 "Health insurance carrier." An entity that offers or issues
- 4 a health insurance policy and is subject to any of the
- 5 following:
- 6 (1) The act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known as
- 7 The Insurance Company Law of 1921, including section 630 and
- 8 Article XXIV of the act.
- 9 (2) The act of December 29, 1972 (P.L.1701, No.364),
- 10 known as the Health Maintenance Organization Act.
- 11 (3) 40 Pa.C.S. Ch. 61 (relating to hospital plan
- 12 corporations) or 63 (relating to professional health services
- 13 plan corporations).
- 14 "Health insurance policy." A policy, contract, certificate
- 15 or agreement offered, issued or renewed by a health insurance
- 16 carrier to provide coverage for health care services. The term
- 17 does not include the following types of policies:
- 18 (1) Accident only.
- 19 (2) Limited benefit.
- 20 (3) Credit.
- 21 (4) Vision.
- 22 (5) Dental.
- 23 (6) Specified disease.
- 24 (7) Civilian Health and Medical Program of the Uniformed
- 25 Services (CHAMPUS) supplement.
- 26 (8) Long-term care or disability income.
- 27 (9) Workers' compensation.
- 28 (10) Automobile medical payment.
- 29 (11) Fixed indemnity.
- 30 (12) HOSPITAL INDEMNITY.

- 1 (13) MEDICARE SUPPLEMENT.
- 2 "Stage four, advanced metastatic cancer." Cancer that has
- 3 spread from the primary or original site of the cancer to nearby
- 4 tissues, lymph nodes or other areas or parts of the body.
- 5 Section 3. Utilization management for stage four, advanced
- 6 metastatic cancer drugs.
- 7 A health insurance carrier or health insurance policy that,
- 8 directly or indirectly, covers the treatment of stage four,
- 9 advanced metastatic cancer may not require an enrollee to first
- 10 fail to successfully respond to a different drug, or prove a
- 11 history of failure in use of a different drug, before providing
- 12 coverage for a COVERED drug to which both of the following
- 13 apply:
- 14 (1) The drug is approved by the United States Food and
- Drug Administration for this indication.
- 16 (2) The use PRESCRIPTION of the drug is consistent with <--

- 17 the best CLINICAL practices for the treatment of stage four, <--
- 18 advanced metastatic cancer or associated condition. A SEVERE <--
- 19 ADVERSE HEALTH CONDITION EXPERIENCED AS A RESULT OF STAGE
- 20 FOUR, ADVANCED METASTATIC CANCER.
- 21 Section 4. Applicability.
- This act shall apply as follows:
- 23 (1) For a health insurance policy for which either rates
- or forms are required to be filed with the Federal Government
- or the Insurance Department, this act shall apply to any
- 26 policy for which a form or rate is first filed on or after
- 27 180 days after the date of enactment EFFECTIVE DATE of this
- 28 act.
- 29 (2) For a health insurance policy for which neither
- 30 rates nor forms are required to be filed with the Federal

- 1 Government or the Insurance Department, this act shall apply
- 2 to any policy issued or renewed on or after 180 days after
- 3 the date of enactment EFFECTIVE DATE of this act. <--
- 4 Section 5. Effective date.
- 5 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
