- Amending the act of June 12, 2018 (P.L.136, No.28), entitled "An act establishing the Pennsylvania Commission for the United States Semiquincentennial; and providing for its powers and duties, " further providing for DEFINITIONS, FOR ESTABLISHMENT, FOR composition and for report to the Governor and the General Assembly. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Sections 4(4) and 9(a) of the act of June 12, 10 2018 (P.L.136, No.28), known as the Pennsylvania Commission for 11 the United States Semiquincentennial Act, are amended to read: 12 SECTION 1.
