AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 13, 1836 (P.L.551, No.169), entitled "An act relating to roads, highways and bridges," further
- providing for repair of private roads.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 15 of the act of June 13, 1836 (P.L.551,
- 7 No.169), referred to as the General Road Law, is amended to
- 8 read:
- 9 Section 15. Repair of private roads
- 10 (a) All private roads shall be opened, fenced and kept in
- 11 repair by and at the expense of the person or persons
- 12 respectively at whose request the same were granted and laid
- 13 out, and by their heirs and assigns.
- 14 (b) In the absence of a written agreement or if the private <--
- 15 road is a part of a planned community under 68 Pa.C.S. (relating
- 16 to real and personal property), when (B) WHEN more than one <--
- 17 person enjoys a common benefit from a private road, each person

- 1 <u>shall contribute in proportion to the amount of private road</u>
- 2 <u>owned UTILIZED to the cost of maintaining the private road AT</u> <--
- 3 THE CURRENT LEVEL OF IMPROVEMENT and shall have the right to
- 4 bring a civil action to enforce the requirement of this section.
- 5 (C) A PERSON SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM CONTRIBUTING TO THE COST <--
- 6 OF MAINTAINING THE PRIVATE ROAD UNDER SUBSECTION (B) IF THE
- 7 PERSON DOES NOT UTILIZE THE PRIVATE ROAD FOR PRIMARY ACCESS TO
- 8 THE PERSON'S PROPERTY.
- 9 (D) THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO PRIVATE ROADS WITH A
- 10 WRITTEN AGREEMENT OR TO PRIVATE ROADS WITHIN A COMMON INTEREST
- 11 OWNERSHIP COMMUNITY UNDER 68 PA.C.S. (RELATING TO REAL AND
- 12 PERSONAL PROPERTY).
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
