4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Chapter 15 of Title 66 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read:

17	<u>§ 1541. Definitions.</u>
18	The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
19	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

1	context clearly indicates otherwise:
2	"Gas." As defined in 49 CFR 192.3 (relating to definitions).
3	"Hazardous liquid." As defined in 49 CFR 195.2 (relating to
4	<u>definitions).</u>
5	"Shutoff valve." A mechanical device used to control the
6	flow of gas or liquid that may be used solely for fully open or
7	closed applications, to control the direction of flow or to
8	throttle flow or regulate pressure. The term includes a plug
9	valve, ball valve, globe valve and gate valve.
10	"Transmission." The transportation, other than gathering, of
11	gas through a transmission line as that term is defined in 49
12	CFR 192.3 or of hazardous liquids through a pipeline as that
13	term is defined in 49 CFR 195.2.
14	<u>§ 1542. Automatic or remote controlled shutoff valves for gas</u>
15	transmission pipelines.
16	(a) General ruleAll facilities of a public utility
17	engaged in the transmission of gas placed into service after the
18	effective date of this section shall have automatic or remote
19	controlled shutoff valves installed as provided under this
20	section.
21	(b) InstallationIn addition to any other valves installed
22	by the public utility, the public utility shall install at least
23	one automatic or remote controlled shutoff valve at each
24	location required under 49 CFR 192.179 (relating to transmission
25	<u>line valves).</u>
26	(c) Testing frequencyThe public utility shall test each
27	automatic and remote controlled shutoff valve on an annual
28	basis. Records of the testing shall be provided annually to each
29	municipality in which the automatic or remote controlled shutoff
30	valve is tested.

3	utility shall repair or replace the valve as soon as reasonably

8	engaged in the transmission of hazardous liquids placed into
9	service after the effective date of this section shall have
10	automatic or remote controlled shutoff valves installed as
11	provided under this section.
12	(b) InstallationIn addition to any other valves installed
13	by the public utility, the public utility shall install at least
14	one automatic or remote controlled shutoff valve at each
15	location required under 49 CFR 192.179 (relating to transmission
16	<u>line valves).</u>
17	(c) Testing frequencyThe public utility shall test each
18	automatic and remote controlled shutoff valve on an annual
19	basis. Records of the testing shall be provided annually to each
20	municipality in which the automatic or remote controlled shutoff
21	valve is tested.
22	(d) ReplacementIf an automatic or remote controlled
23	shutoff valve does not operate properly when tested, the public
24	utility shall repair or replace the valve as soon as reasonably
25	practicable.

27	The commission may, after notice and opportunity to be heard,
28	impose civil penalties under section 3301 (relating to civil
29	penalties for violations) and other appropriate remedies for
