AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in financial responsibility, further providing for
3 required financial responsibility.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1786 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8 § 1786. Required financial responsibility.

10 (e.1) Obligation of notice regarding new contract.--

11 (1) An insurer who has issued a new contract of motor
12 vehicle liability insurance, or any approved self-insurance
13 entity, shall notify the following of the new contract:

14 (i) The Department of Transportation in a timely
15 manner and in a method prescribed by the department's
16 regulations.

17 (ii) The lienholder of the motor vehicle, if any,

1 within 10 days of the issuance of the new contract.

2 (iii) The person leasing the motor vehicle to the
3 insured, if any, within 10 days of the issuance of the
4 new contract.

5 (2) A violation of paragraph (1) shall be deemed to be
6 an unfair or deceptive act or practice in violation of the
7 act of December 17, 1968 (P.L.1224, No.387), known as the
8 Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer Protection Law.

9 * * *

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
