- 2 (3) One member of the House of Representatives appointed by

- 4 (4) One member of the House of Representatives appointed by

- 6 (5) (1) Two individuals representing community pharmacists <--
- 7 appointed by the secretary.
- 8 (6) Medical directors, external physicians, pharmacists, <--
- 9 <u>consumer advocates and specialists</u> (2) PHYSICIANS, PHARMACISTS <--
- 10 AND OTHER MEMBERS appointed by the secretary as needed to
- 11 develop and maintain a preferred drug list.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
