## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in Commonwealth services, providing
- for certified fire protection specialist misrepresentation.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Chapter 73 of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read:
- 8 SUBCHAPTER C.1
- 9 <u>CERTIFIED FIRE PROTECTION SPECIALIST MISREPRESENTATION</u>

- 11 <u>7341. Scope of subchapter.</u>
- 12 <u>7342</u>. Fire protection specialist certification.
- 13 § 7341. Scope of subchapter.
- 14 This subchapter relates to certified fire protection
- 15 <u>specialist misrepresentation</u>.
- 16 § 7342. Fire protection specialist certification.
- 17 (a) Misrepresentation. -- An individual who is not duly
- 18 certified as a fire protection specialist by the National Fire

- 1 Protection Association may not hold himself out as a certified
- 2 fire protection specialist with the intent to deceive another
- 3 person.
- 4 (b) Certification list. -- To the greatest extent possible,
- 5 the Office of the State Fire Commissioner shall obtain and
- 6 maintain a current list of certified fire protection specialists
- 7 <u>as provided by the National Fire Protection Association.</u>
- 8 (c) Penalties. -- An individual who violates subsection (a)
- 9 commits a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be
- 10 sentenced as follows:
- 11 (1) For a first offense, to pay a fine of not more than
- 12 \$250.
- 13 (2) For a second or subsequent offense, to pay a fine of
- 14 <u>not more than \$1,000 or imprisonment for not more than six</u>
- months, or both.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
