AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An  
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain  
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial  
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the  
5 laws relating thereto," in vocational education, providing  
6 for attendance of pupils in home education programs.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known  
10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a  
11 section to read:

12 Section 1847.1. Attendance of Pupils in Home Education  
13 Programs.--On obtaining the consent of the area vocational-  
14 technical board operating an area vocational-technical school or  
15 technical institute, and with or without the consent of the  
16 board of school directors of the district in which the pupil  
17 resides, any pupil in a home education program under section  
18 1327.1 may attend the area vocational-technical school or  
19 technical institute. The school district in which the pupil

1 resides shall be charged, for each pupil attending the area  
2 vocational-technical school or technical institute, an amount  
3 equal to the total approved budget for current expenses, debt  
4 service and capital outlay divided by the number of pupils  
5 enrolled in the school.

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
