AN ACT

1 Making appropriations from the Tobacco Settlement Fund for the  
2 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and for the payment of  
3 bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the  
4 fiscal year ending June 30, 2020.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

8 PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

9 Section 101. Short title.

10 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Appropriation  
11 Act of 2019 - Tobacco Settlement Fund.

13 TOBACCO SETTLEMENT FUND APPROPRIATIONS

14 FOR 2019-2020

15 Section 301. Appropriations from Tobacco Settlement Fund.

16 The following amounts, or as much thereof as may be  
17 necessary, are hereby appropriated from the Tobacco Settlement  
18 Fund to the departments and for the purposes specified in this  
19 part for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and for the

1 payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of  
2 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020.

3 Section 302. Department of Community and Economic Development.
