AN ACT

1 Making appropriations from the General Fund to the Pennsylvania
2 Higher Education Assistance Agency for the fiscal year
3 beginning July 1, 2019, and for the payment of bills incurred
4 and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending
5 June 30, 2020.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 PART I

9 PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

10 Section 101. Short title.

11 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Appropriation
12 Act of 2019 - Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency.

13 PART III

14 GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS

15 FOR 2019-2020

16 Section 301. Appropriations from General Fund.

17 The following amounts, or as much thereof as may be
18 necessary, are hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the
19 Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency for the purposes
20 specified in this part for the fiscal year beginning July 1,

1 2019, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid
2 at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020:

3 Federal State

4 For payment of education
5 assistance grants.

6 State appropriation..... 273,391,000

7 For Pennsylvania Internship
8 program grants.

9 State appropriation..... 450,000

10 For Ready to Succeed
11 Scholarships.

12 State appropriation..... 5,000,000

13 For matching payments for
14 student aid funds.

15 State appropriation..... 12,496,000

16 For institutional assistance
17 grants to be allotted by the
18 Pennsylvania Higher Education
19 Assistance Agency.

20 State appropriation..... 26,521,000

21 For higher education for the
22 disadvantaged.

23 State appropriation..... 2,246,000

24 For higher education for blind
25 and deaf students.

26 State appropriation..... 47,000

27 For the Horace Mann Bond-
28 Leslie Pinckney Hill Scholarship
29 and for outreach and recruitment
30 activities at Lincoln and Cheyney

1 Universities related to the
2 scholarship. This appropriation
3 also contains funds for the
4 continuation of support to
5 students currently receiving
6 equal opportunity professional
7 education awards.

8 State appropriation..... 697,000

9 For the Cheyney University

10 Keystone Academy.

11 State appropriation..... 1,813,000

13 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

14 Section 501. (Reserved).

15 Section 502. Effective date.
