AN ACT

1 Making appropriations from the Hazardous Material Response Fund
2 to the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency for the
3 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and for the payment of
4 bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the
5 fiscal year ending June 30, 2020.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 PART I

9 PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

10 Section 101. Short title.

11 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Appropriation
12 Act of 2019 - Hazardous Material Response Fund.

14 HAZARDOUS MATERIAL RESPONSE FUND APPROPRIATIONS

15 FOR 2019-2020

16 Section 301. Appropriations from Hazardous Material Response
17 Fund.

18 The following amounts, or as much thereof as may be
19 necessary, are hereby appropriated from the Hazardous Material
20 Response Fund to the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency

1 for the purposes specified in this part for the fiscal year
2 beginning July 1, 2019, and for the payment of bills incurred
3 and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June
4 30, 2020.

5 Section 302. Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency.

6 The following amounts are

7 appropriated to the Pennsylvania

8 Emergency Management Agency: Federal State

9 For general administration and

10 operational expenses.

11 State appropriation..... 190,000

12 For training programs for
13 hazardous material response teams.

14 State appropriation..... 190,000

15 For grants to support counties'
16 activities.

17 State appropriation..... 1,330,000

18 For public and facility owner
19 education, information and
20 participation programs.

21 State appropriation..... 190,000

23 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

24 Section 501. (Reserved).

25 Section 502. Effective date.

26 This act shall take effect July 1, 2019, or immediately,
27 whichever is later.
