AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in particular rights and 2 immunities, providing for contracts or agreements for 3 nondisclosure of certain conduct. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 8316.2. Contracts or agreements for nondisclosure of certain 10 conduct. 11 (a) Prohibition. No person may enter into, 12 any agreement, contract, settlement or similar instrument that 13 includes a provision that: 14 (A) VOID PROVISIONS.--A PROVISION OF AN AGREEMENT, CONTRACT, <--15 SETTLEMENT OR SIMILAR INSTRUMENT THAT DOES ANY OF THE FOLLOWING 16 SHALL BE VOID AND UNENFORCEABLE: (1) prohibits or attempts to prohibit the disclosure of 17

the name of a person suspected of childhood sexual abuse to

- 1 law enforcement authorities; 2 (2) suppresses or attempts to suppress information 3 relevant to an investigation by law enforcement authorities into a claim of childhood sexual abuse; or 4 5 (3) impairs or attempts to impair the ability of a 6 person to report a claim of childhood sexual abuse to law 7 enforcement authorities. 8 (b) Void provisions. A provision of any agreement, <--9 contract, settlement or similar instrument that is contrary to 10 this section shall be void and unenforceable. (B) FORM.--A PROVISION OF AN AGREEMENT, CONTRACT, SETTLEMENT <--11 OR SIMILAR INSTRUMENT NOT SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (A) SHALL BE 12 13 PRESUMED TO BE VALID AND ENFORCEABLE IF IT INCLUDES A NOTICE PRINTED IN BOLDFACE, 12-POINT FONT OR LARGER, AS FOLLOWS OR IN A 14 SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR FORM: 15 16 NOTICE TO ALL PARTIES BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT, YOU DO NOT SURRENDER YOUR RIGHT TO 17 18 SPEAK TO LAW ENFORCEMENT ABOUT THE ACTIONS, UNDERLYING FACTS OR 19 CIRCUMSTANCES REFERENCED IN THIS AGREEMENT. 20 I (WE) ACKNOWLEDGE RECEIPT OF THE ABOVE NOTICE. 21 (SIGNATURE).....(DATE)..... (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following 22 23 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this 24 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: 25 "Childhood sexual abuse." Conduct that is subject to 23 26 Pa.C.S. Ch. 63 (relating to child protective services) and is 27 directed toward or against a child or student, regardless of the 28 age of the child or student.
- 29 "Law enforcement authorities." An individual or entity
- 30 <u>charged with the enforcement of Federal, State or local laws.</u>

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
