AN ACT

1 Designating the highway interchange of U.S. Route 422 with
2 Pennsylvania Route 66, Manor Township, Armstrong County, as
3 the Senator Donald C. White Interchange.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Senator Donald C. White Interchange.

7 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
8 follows:

9 (1) Senator Donald C. White dedicated 18 years to
10 serving his community and this Commonwealth in the Senate.

11 (2) Senator White, born August 5, 1950, is a former
12 Republican member of the Senate representing the 41st
13 District, which includes Indiana County, Armstrong County and
14 parts of Butler County and Westmoreland County.

15 (3) In 2000, Senator White, an independent insurance
16 broker with more than 20 years of experience in the industry,
17 won the election for the 41st District Senate seat.

1 (4) Senator White went on to win four subsequent
2 reelections before retiring from the Senate in February 2019.

3 (5) During his tenure, Senator White served for 12 years
4 as the chairman of the Senate Banking and Insurance Committee
5 and was respected by both sides of the aisle for his
6 expertise in those subjects.

7 (6) Senator White also served as vice chairman of the
8 Senate Transportation Committee and as a member of the
9 Community, Economic and Recreational Development Committee,
10 Environmental Resources and Energy Committee, Veterans
11 Affairs and Emergency Preparedness Committee and Labor and
12 Industry Committee.

13 (7) Among his many accomplishments, Senator White was
14 the prime sponsor of a law that revamped Pennsylvania's
15 insurance insolvency laws and minimized increases in workers'
16 compensation premium costs.

17 (8) Senator White is also a member of the PENNVEST Board
18 of Directors, the independent authority that serves the
19 communities and citizens of Pennsylvania by funding sewer,
20 storm water and drinking water projects, and served in the
21 United States Army 1972 to 1975.

22 (9) Senator White's leadership and efforts on behalf of
23 his constituents and all Pennsylvanians deserve to be
24 commended.

25 (b) Designation.--The highway interchange of U.S. Route 422
26 with Pennsylvania Route 66, Manor Township, Armstrong County, is
27 designated the Senator Donald C. White Interchange.

28 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
29 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
30 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

1 Section 2. Effective date.

2 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
