7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 1517(a) and (e) of the act of March 10,
10	1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,
11	are amended and the section is amended by adding subsections to
12	read:
13	Section 1517. Fire, School Security and Emergency Evacuation
14	Drills(a) Except as provided under subsection (a.1), in all
15	school buildings of school entities where fire-escapes,
16	appliances for the extinguishment of fires, or proper and
17	sufficient exits in case of fire or panic, either or all, are
18	required by law to be maintained, fire drills shall be
19	periodically conducted, not less than one a month[, by the
20	teacher or teachers in charge] while the school entity is in

session and students are present, under [rules and regulations 1 2 to be promulgated] policies adopted by the chief school 3 administrator under whose supervision such school entities are. In such fire drills the pupils and teachers shall be instructed 4 in, and made thoroughly familiar with, the use of the fire-5 escapes, appliances and exits. The drill shall include the 6 7 actual use thereof, and the complete removal of the pupils and 8 teachers, in an expeditious and orderly manner, by means of 9 fire-escapes and exits, from the building to a place of safety 10 on the ground outside.

12 (a.2) A record of all fire, school security and emergency 13 evacuation drills shall be completed by the principal or person in charge at each school building and shall be accurate and up-14 to-date and kept on file in the respective school offices. The 15 16 principal or person in charge shall submit the record to the chief school administrator and the Department of Education by 17 18 June 30 each year for review by the department for compliance 19 with this section. The Department of Education shall determine the manner and form of the record to be used to document the 20 fire, school security and emergency evacuation drills by the 21 principal or person in charge at each school building. The 22 23 record must include, at a minimum, the following: 24 (1) The date and time of the drill. 25 (2) The duration of the drill. 26 (3) The drill type.

27 <u>(4) The signature of the principal or person in charge.</u>

(e) On or before the tenth day of April of each year, eachchief school administrator shall certify to the Department of

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1	Education that the <u>fire and</u> emergency evacuation drills and
2	school security drills herein required have been conducted in
3	accordance with this section[.] and documented in the record by
4	the principal or person in charge of each school building.
5	(e.1) The Department of Education, by September 1, 2020, and
6	each August 1 thereafter, shall provide annually a report on
7	Statewide compliance with the provisions of this section to the
8	Education Committee of the Senate, the Education Committee of
9	the House of Representatives and the State Fire Commissioner and
10	shall make the report available on the department's publicly
11	accessible Internet website.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
