AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in preliminary provisions, providing 5
- for study of school mental health professionals. 6
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 128. Study of School Mental Health Professionals.
- 13 (a) The department shall conduct a study of public schools
- 14 regarding school mental health professionals, which shall
- 15 include the following:
- 16 (1) The number of full-time and part-time school counselors,
- school social workers and school psychologists in each school in 17

- 1 this Commonwealth.
- 2 (2) In each school in this Commonwealth, the ratio of
- 3 students to:
- 4 <u>(i) school counselors;</u>
- 5 (ii) school social workers; and
- 6 (iii) school psychologists.
- 7 (3) Whether a school counselor, school social worker or
- 8 <u>school psychologist is providing counseling assistance to more</u>
- 9 than one school.
- 10 (4) The nationally accepted ratios of students to:
- 11 (i) school counselors;
- 12 (ii) school social workers; and
- 13 <u>(iii) school psychologists.</u>
- 14 (5) Recommendations regarding how a school can increase the
- 15 number of school counselors, school social workers and school
- 16 psychologists to meet the nationally accepted ratios.
- 17 (b) The department shall prepare a report based on the study
- 18 conducted under subsection (a) and shall submit the report by
- 19 December 21, 2021, to the chairperson and the minority
- 20 chairperson of the Education Committee of the Senate and the
- 21 chairperson and minority chairperson of the Education Committee
- 22 of the House of Representatives.
- 23 (c) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 24 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 25 <u>the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 26 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 27 <u>Commonwealth.</u>
- 28 "School counselor." A person licensed and certified by the
- 29 Commonwealth as a school counselor and hired to provide
- 30 individual or group counseling assistance to students in the

- 1 <u>elementary</u>, <u>middle or high school grades</u>.
- 2 "School psychologist." A person licensed and certified by
- 3 the Commonwealth as a school psychologist and hired to provide
- 4 <u>individual or group counseling assistance to students in the</u>
- 5 <u>elementary</u>, <u>middle or high school grades</u>.
- 6 "School social worker." A person licensed and certified by
- 7 the Commonwealth as a school social worker and hired to provide
- 8 <u>individual or group counseling assistance to students in the</u>
- 9 <u>elementary</u>, <u>middle or high school grades</u>.
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
