AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for USA
3 semiquincentennial registration plates.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 1369.4. USA semiquincentennial registration plates.

9 (a) General rule.--The department shall design a special USA
10 semiquincentennial registration plate.

11 (b) Application and payment.--Upon application and payment
12 of a fee of \$50 by a person, which shall be in addition to the
13 ~~annual~~ registration fee, the department shall issue a USA
14 semiquincentennial registration plate for a motorcycle, a
15 passenger car or a truck with a registered gross weight of not
16 more than 14,000 pounds or a motor home.

17 (c) Description of plate.--The plate shall include the

1 phrase "Let Freedom Ring - 250 years" and feature the Liberty <--
2 Bell.
3 (d) Expiration.--This section shall expire December 31,
4 2026.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 120 days.
