- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for
- 3 Pennsylvania 1950s and 1960s heritage registration plates.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 1369.4. Pennsylvania 1950s and 1960s heritage registration
- 9 plates.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- The department shall design two distinct
- 11 heritage registration plates representing the 1950s and the
- 12 1960s.
- 13 (b) Application and payment. -- Upon application and payment
- 14 of an additional registration A fee of \$50 by a person, WHICH
- 15 SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE, the
- 16 <u>department shall issue a heritage registration plate for a</u>
- 17 motorcycle, a passenger car or a truck with a registered gross

- 1 weight of not more than 14,000 pounds or a motor home. The
 2 following shall apply:
- (1) The 1950s plate shall be a blue background with a 3 4 vellow gold outline of the State with the Pennsylvania 1956 general issuance plate as the basis of the design. THE 5 <--6 LETTERS, NUMBERS AND OUTLINE OF THE STATE ON THE PLATE SHALL 7 BE STAMPED INTO THE SURFACE OF THE PLATE SUCH THAT THE 8 LETTERS, NUMBERS AND OUTLINE OF THE STATE ARE RAISED FROM THE 9 SURFACE OF THE PLATE IN A MANNER THAT IS SIMILAR TO THE DESIGN OF THE PENNSYLVANIA 1956 GENERAL ISSUANCE PLATE. 10 (2) The 1960s plate shall be a yellow gold background 11 12 with a blue outline of the State with the Pennsylvania 1967 13 general issuance plate as the basis of the design. THE <--14 LETTERS, NUMBERS AND OUTLINE OF THE STATE ON THE PLATE SHALL
- 15 BE STAMPED INTO THE SURFACE OF THE PLATE SUCH THAT THE
- 16 <u>LETTERS, NUMBERS AND OUTLINE OF THE STATE ARE RAISED FROM THE</u>
- 17 SURFACE OF THE PLATE IN A MANNER THAT IS SIMILAR TO THE
- 18 <u>DESIGN OF THE PENNSYLVANIA 1967 GENERAL ISSUANCE PLATE.</u>
- 19 <u>(c) Expiration. This section shall expire December 31, </u> <--
- 20 2026.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 120 days. <--
