Certified copies of records. * * * 10 11 (b) State Police reports. -- [The] 12 (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2), the fee for 13 a certified Pennsylvania State Police record of investigation of a vehicle accident which the Pennsylvania State Police are 14 15 authorized by this title to furnish to the public shall be 16 \$22 for each copy of the Pennsylvania State Police full report of investigation. 17

(2) The fee under paragraph (1) shall not be charged to
