AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 1002, also
2 known as Friend Lea Road, over U.S. Route 219 in Cambria
3 Township, Cambria County, as the PFC Cyril T. Yeckley
4 Memorial Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. PFC Cyril T. Yeckley Memorial Bridge.

8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds that:

9 (1) PFC Cyril T. Yeckley was born October 20, 1945, in
10 Carrolltown Borough, Cambria County.

11 (2) He enlisted in the United States Marine Corps and
12 began a tour of duty in Quang Nam Province, South Vietnam, on
13 February 23, 1969, as a rifleman with the 1st Marine <--
14 Division, 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines, L Company. L COMPANY, <--
15 3RD BATTALION, 5TH MARINE REGIMENT, 1ST MARINE DIVISION.

16 (3) Less than one month later, on March 13, 1969, PFC
17 Yeckley was killed in action after receiving multiple

1 fragmentation wounds.

2 (b) Designation.--The bridge located on State Route 1002,
3 also known as Friend Lea Road, over U.S. Route 219 in Cambria
4 Township, Cambria County, is designated the PFC Cyril T. Yeckley
5 Memorial Bridge.

6 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
7 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
8 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

9 Section 2. Effective date.

10 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
