AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for special
3 plates for current members or veterans of the 28th Infantry
4 Division.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 1369.4. Special plates for current members or veterans of the
10 28th Infantry Division.

11 Upon application of a person who is a current member or
12 veteran of the 28th Infantry Division of the Pennsylvania
13 National Guard, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in
14 addition to the registration fee and by such documentation as
15 the department shall require, the department shall issue to the
16 person a special registration plate designating the vehicle so
17 licensed as belonging to a person who is a current member or
18 veteran of the 28th Infantry Division of the Pennsylvania

1 National Guard. The department shall design and produce the
2 special registration plate to display the 28th Infantry
3 Division's combat service identification badge. The special
4 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck
5 with registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds.

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
