AN ACT

1 Amending the act of July 14, 1961 (P.L.604, No.304), entitled
2 "An act relating to apprenticeship and training; creating a
3 State Apprenticeship and Training Council in the Department
4 of Labor and Industry to formulate an apprenticeship and
5 training policy and program, and defining its powers and
6 duties and providing for administration," providing for
7 review.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. The act of July 14, 1961 (P.L.604, No.304), known
11 as The Apprenticeship and Training Act, is amended by adding a
12 section to read:

13 Section 6.1. Review.--The Department of Labor and Industry,
14 in consultation with the council and the United States
15 Department of Labor Employment and Training Administration,
16 Office of Apprenticeship, shall conduct a review of this act to
17 determine whether amendments are necessary to comply with
18 applicable Federal law and regulations governing apprenticeship
19 programs. The following shall apply: (1) within ninety (90)
20 days of the effective date of this section, the Department of

1 Labor and Industry shall report its findings to the chairman and
2 minority chairman of the Labor and Industry Committee of the
3 Senate and the chairman and minority chairman of the Labor and
4 Industry Committee of the House of Representatives; and (2)
5 the report shall include recommendations for amendments to this
6 act that will be necessary to comply with applicable Federal law
7 and regulations governing apprenticeship programs.

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
