AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 11414, on U.S.
2 Route 219 in Brady Township, Clearfield County, as the Lance
3 Corporal Robert Clyde Gontero Memorial Bridge.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Lance Corporal Robert Clyde Gontero Memorial Bridge.

7 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
8 follows:

9 (1) Lance Corporal Robert Clyde Gontero, a native of
10 Luthersburg, Clearfield County, gave his life in service to
11 his country during the Vietnam War.

12 (2) Lance Corporal Gontero graduated from DuBois Area
13 High School and enlisted in the United States Marine Corps on
14 August 6, 1968.

15 (3) Lance Corporal Gontero served with the 3rd
16 Battalion, 5th Marines, First Division.

1 (4) On June 26, 1969, Lance Corporal Gontero was killed
2 in action as a result of a gunshot wound from rifle fire
3 while on a search and clear mission in Quang Nam, South
4 Vietnam.

5 (b) Designation.--The bridge, identified as Bridge Key
6 11414, on U.S. Route 219 in Brady Township, Clearfield County,
7 is designated the Lance Corporal Robert Clyde Gontero Memorial
8 Bridge.

9 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
10 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
11 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

12 Section 2. Effective date.

13 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
