## AN ACT

- 1 Designating the portion of County Line Road between Warminster
- 2 Road and Newtown Road in Montgomery County as the Captain
- William J. Ahlum Memorial Highway.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Captain William J. Ahlum Memorial Highway.
- 7 (a) Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (1) On March 23, 1969, Captain William John Ahlum of
- 10 Hatboro was killed in Vietnam.
- 11 (2) Cpt. Ahlum served in the Army and was a commissioned
- officer through The Pennsylvania Military College, now
- Widener University, in Chester, Pennsylvania.
- 14 (3) Captain Ahlum was in Vietnam for only a few weeks
- 15 when he was killed in Binh Dinh Province, South Vietnam.
- 16 (4) At the time of his death, Cpt. Ahlum was serving in
- 17 the 1st Logistical Command, 184th Ordnance Battalion.
- 18 (5) Cpt. Ahlum was the recipient of the Purple Heart,
- 19 National Defense Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal, Vietnam

- 1 Service Medal, Distinguished Service Medal, Vietnam Gallantry
- 2 Cross Unit Citation and Good Conduct Medal.
- 3 (b) Designation. -- The portion of County Line Road between
- 4 Warminster Road and Newtown Road in Montgomery County is
- 5 designated as the Captain William J. Ahlum Memorial Highway.
- 6 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 7 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
- 8 traffic in both directions on the highway.
- 9 Section 2. Effective date.
- 10 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
