AN ACT

1 Amending Title 74 (Transportation) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for Pennsylvania State  
3 Police funding from Motor License Fund; and making a related  
4 repeal.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 74 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
8 Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:

9 CHAPTER 97

10 PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE FUNDING

14 § 9701. Restrictions.

15 An appropriation from the Motor License Fund to the  
16 Pennsylvania State Police is restricted as follows:

17 (1) For fiscal year 2017-2018, the total amount of the  
18 appropriation shall not exceed the total amount appropriated

1 for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017.

2 (2) For fiscal year 2018-2019, the total amount of the  
3 appropriation shall not exceed 96% of the total amount  
4 appropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017.

5 (3) For fiscal year 2019-2020, the total amount of the  
6 appropriation shall not exceed 92% of the total amount  
7 appropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017.

8 (4) For fiscal year 2020-2021, the total amount of the  
9 appropriation shall not exceed 84% of the total amount  
10 appropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017.

11 (5) For fiscal year 2021-2022, the total amount of the  
12 appropriation shall not exceed 76% of the total amount  
13 appropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017.

14 (6) For fiscal year 2022-2023, the total amount of the  
15 appropriation shall not exceed 68% of the total amount  
16 appropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017.

17 (7) For fiscal year 2023-2024, the total amount of the  
18 appropriation shall not exceed 60% of the total amount  
19 appropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017.

20 (8) For fiscal year 2024-2025 and each fiscal year  
21 thereafter, the total amount of the appropriation shall not  
22 exceed the greater of:

23 (i) \$500,000,000; or

24 (ii) 60% of the total amount appropriated for the  
25 same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017.

26 Section 2. Repeals are as follows:

27 (1) The General Assembly finds that the repeal under  
28 paragraph (2) is necessary to effectuate this act.

29 (2) Section 1798.2-E of the act of April 9, 1929  
30 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, is repealed.

1 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
