Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania

AN ACT

Consolidated Statutes, in service and facilities, providing for overhead utility pole repair by public utility. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 1512. Overhead utility pole repair by public utility. 8 9 (a) Maintenance of overhead utility pole. -- A public utility 10 whose distribution infrastructure includes the responsibility of 11 maintenance of overhead utility poles, on notification by the 12 municipality of a damaged or hazardous pole located within its jurisdiction, shall, within 30 days from the notification under 13 this subsection: 14 15 (1) replace the damaged overhead utility pole with a new 16 pole; or (2) repair the damaged overhead utility pole to a new 17 and safe condition where the pole must be a single pole 18

- 1 <u>secured in the ground. If the overhead utility pole cannot be</u>
- 2 <u>sufficiently repaired, the pole shall be removed in its</u>
- 3 entirety and all overhead lines must be removed and placed on
- 4 <u>a new overhead utility pole.</u>
- 5 (b) Explanation of delay. -- The public utility shall explain
- 6 any delay in the repair or replacement of the damaged overhead
- 7 <u>utility pole to the municipality if the public utility fails to</u>
- 8 meet the requirements of subsection (a).
- 9 (c) Complaint.--If after 90 days from the notification to
- 10 the public utility under subsection (a) the public utility has
- 11 <u>failed to meet the requirements of subsection (a), the</u>
- 12 <u>municipality may file a complaint with the commission for any</u>
- 13 <u>insufficient</u>, <u>defective</u>, <u>noncompliant</u> or <u>incomplete</u> repair of an
- 14 <u>overhead utility pole. The commission shall immediately set a</u>
- 15 time for a hearing and provide notice under section 703
- 16 <u>(relating to fixing of hearings) to the public utility of the</u>
- 17 complaint for failure to comply with this section.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
