## AN ACT

Designating the Faxon Interchange of Interstate 180 at Northway Road in Loyalsock Township, Lycoming County, as the <del>United</del> States Army Sgt. Thomas H. Woodruff, Sr., and <del>United States</del> <--3 <--Marine Corps Sqt. Hamilton T. Woodruff Memorial Interchange. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. United States Army Sgt. Thomas H. Woodruff, Sr., and <--8 United States Marine Corps Sgt. Hamilton T. Woodruff <--9 Memorial Interchange. 10 (a) Findings. --11 United States Army Sqt. Thomas H. Woodruff, Sr., 12 lived most of his life in Loyalsock Township. 13 Sgt. Thomas Woodruff served in the United States 14 Army during the Korean Conflict as a supply sergeant. After 15 returning home from active duty, he continued a life of service. 16

- 1 (3) In 1948, Sgt. Thomas Woodruff joined the Loyalsock 2 Township Volunteer Fire Company No. 1, where he served in 3 various capacities.
- 4 (4) In addition to being appointed Justice of the Peace,
  5 Sgt. Thomas Woodruff was also elected as a member of the
  6 Loyalsock Township School Board.
- 7 (5) Sadly in May 2000, after battling cancer, Sgt. 8 Thomas Woodruff passed away.
- 9 (6) He is survived by his wife of 45 years, the former
  10 Shirley Boyer, and children Carol (Dave) Yorks, Thomas (Tami)
  11 Woodruff, Jr., Howard (Dawn) Woodruff, Robert Woodruff and
  12 Susan (Scott) Lorson. He also is survived by two
  13 granddaughters, six grandsons and one great granddaughter, <-14 TWO GREAT-GRANDDAUGHTERS AND TWO GREAT-GRANDSONS.
- 15 (7) Sgt. Thomas Woodruff's grandson, United States
  16 Marine Corps Sgt. Hamilton T. Woodruff, was born in
  17 Williamsport, Pennsylvania.
  - (8) Sgt. Hamilton Woodruff attended DuBoistown
    Elementary School, South Williamsport Area Junior High School
    and Mansfield Area High School, where he graduated as the
    president and salutatorian of his class in 2004. Between his
    junior and senior years, he accepted early enlistment in the
    United States Marine Corps.
  - (9) While serving in the United States Marine Corps,
    Sgt. Hamilton Woodruff served as an Arabic translator. As a
    member of the Recon Group, Sgt. Hamilton Woodruff intercepted
    and interpreted communications that had targeted his fellow
    troops.
- 29 (10) On April 13, 2009, Sgt. Hamilton Woodruff was 30 involved in a vehicle accident while returning to Camp

- 1 Lejeune, North Carolina, and died the next day, April 14,

- 3 (11) Sqt. Hamilton Woodruff posthumously received a Navy
- 4 and Marine Corps Achievement Medal for his lifesaving work in
- 5 the Marine Corps.
- 6 (b) Designation.--The Faxon Interchange of Interstate 180 at
- 7 Northway Road in Loyalsock Township, Lycoming County, is
- 8 designated as the <del>United States Army</del> Sgt. Thomas H. Woodruff, <--
- 9 Sr., and <del>United States Marine Corps</del> Sgt. Hamilton <del>T.</del> Woodruff
- 10 Memorial Interchange.
- 11 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 12 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway
- 13 INTERCHANGE to traffic in both directions on the highway <--

- 15 Section 2. Effective date.
