AN ACT

Amending the act of May 2, 1947 (P.L.143, No.62), entitled "An 1 act regulating the sale and resale for profit and the carrying on of the business of selling or reselling tickets 3 or other devices for admission to places of amusement; providing for the licensing of persons reselling such tickets 5 for profit; providing for the suspension and revocation of 6 such licenses; imposing duties on licensees and owners or 7 operators of places of amusement; imposing powers and duties 8 on the Department of Revenue, county treasurers, district 9 attorneys, and the receiver of taxes, and city solicitors in 10 cities of the first class; making disposition of moneys 11 collected and providing penalties," providing for event 12 ticket purchase protection. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 15 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. - 5 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 6 <u>Section 12.2. Event Ticket Purchase Protection.--</u>
- 7 (a) If a ticketed event is canceled due to the declaration
- 8 of a disaster emergency by the Governor pursuant to the
- 9 <u>authority granted under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) (relating to</u>
- 10 general authority of Governor), the issuer of the ticket shall
- 11 refund the full purchase price of the ticket to the purchaser.
- 12 (b) The refund required by this section shall be made by the
- 13 <u>issuer of the ticket not later than thirty (30) days following</u>
- 14 receipt of the written request for refund by the purchaser. In
- 15 addition to a written request for refund, the purchaser may
- 16 <u>elect to submit an electronic request for refund when electronic</u>
- 17 <u>submission is available through the issuer's Internet website.</u>
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
