## AN ACT

- Amending Title 68 (Real and Personal Property) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for broadband
- 3 services.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 68 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:
- 8 CHAPTER 82
- 9 <u>BROADBAND SERVICES</u>
- 10 <u>Sec.</u>
- 11 <u>8201</u>. <u>Definitions</u>.
- 12 8202. Broadband services.
- 13 § 8201. Definitions.
- 14 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 15 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 16 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 1 "AFFILIATE." A PERSON THAT DIRECTLY, OR INDIRECTLY THROUGH <--
- 2 ONE OR MORE INTERMEDIARIES, CONTROLS, IS CONTROLLED BY OR IS
- 3 UNDER COMMON CONTROL WITH A SPECIFIED PERSON. THE TERM INCLUDES
- 4 SUBSIDIARIES, PARTNERSHIPS, JOINT VENTURES AND OTHER ENTITIES
- 5 THAT HAVE SHARED RESOURCES, INTERESTS OR BUSINESS DEALINGS.
- 6 <u>"Broadband facilities." Wires, cables, materials, equipment</u>
- 7 and other facilities, which are or can be used for the provision
- 8 of broadband services.
- 9 <u>"Broadband service supplier."</u> An electricity,
- 10 telecommunications, CABLE OPERATOR or Internet supplier or <--
- 11 affiliate that constructs, owns or installs new broadband
- 12 facilities to provide broadband services, at wholesale or
- 13 retail, through USING existing electric infrastructure within an <--
- 14 <u>easement</u>, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, POLES AND CONDUIT, <--
- 15 WITHIN AN EASEMENT. The term includes third parties with which
- 16 the electricity supplier ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION <--
- 17 contracts, licenses or otherwise enters into agreements with for
- 18 the installation, service or maintenance of broadband
- 19 infrastructure and provision of broadband services on behalf of
- 20 the electricity supplier ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION or ITS <--
- 21 affiliate.
- 22 "Broadband services." As follows:
- 23 (1) Service that consists of or includes the provision
- of broadband that:
- 25 <u>(i) is used to provide access to the Internet; or</u>
- 26 (ii) provides computer processing, information
- 27 storage, information content or protocol conversion.
- 28 (2) The term includes the provision of video services,
- 29 voice over Internet protocol services, wireless services and
- 30 Internet protocol-enabled services.

- 1 "Easement." A recorded or unrecorded right-of-way, easement
- 2 or similar property right acquired by eminent domain,
- 3 prescription or conveyance that is used or may be used for
- 4 transmitting, distributing or providing electric service by
- 5 <u>utilizing electric infrastructure.</u>
- 6 <u>"Electric cooperative corporation."</u> As defined in 15 Pa.C.S.
- 7 § 7302(a) (relating to application of chapter).
- 8 <u>"Electricity supplier." A person engaged in providing</u>
- 9 electricity, at wholesale or retail, including a public utility,

- 10 municipal corporation or authority or an electric cooperative
- 11 corporation.
- 12 § 8202. Broadband services.
- 13 (a) Broadband facilities. -- The following apply:
- 14 (1) An electric cooperative corporation or an affiliate
- of an electric cooperative corporation may provide broadband
- services or construct, operate and maintain broadband
- facilities through an existing easement owned, held or used
- 18 by the electric cooperative corporation. AN ELECTRIC
- 19 COOPERATIVE CORPORATION MAY ONLY SUPPLY RETAIL BROADBAND
- 20 SERVICES THROUGH ONE OR MORE AFFILIATES.
- 21 (2) Except as provided for under subsection (b), the
- 22 attachment of broadband facilities shall not constitute a
- 23 change to the physical use of the easement, interfere with or
- impair any vested rights of the property owner subject to the
- 25 easement or place an additional burden on the property or
- interests of the owner.
- 27 (3) A broadband service supplier that is not an electric
- 28 cooperative corporation may access and attach broadband
- 29 facilities within an electric <del>cooperative's</del> COOPERATIVE
- 30 CORPORATION'S easement:

1	(i) if an electric cooperative CORPORATION or its	<
2	affiliates have attached broadband facilities to provide	
3	retail or wholesale broadband services OR IF AN ELECTRIC	<
4	COOPERATIVE CORPORATION, IN ITS SOLE DISCRETION, GIVES	
5	EXPRESS WRITTEN PERMISSION TO A BROADBAND SERVICE	
6	PROVIDER TO UTILIZE AN EXISTING ELECTRIC EASEMENT; and	
7	(ii) subject to the terms of applicable safety	
8	standards, the structural integrity of the electric	
9	infrastructure and the electric cooperative corporation's	_
10	rules and fees for the attachments.	
11	(4) AN ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION THAT ELECTS TO	<
12	PROVIDE BROADBAND SERVICES AS A BROADBAND SERVICE SUPPLIER	
13	SHALL PERMIT OTHER PROVIDERS OF SUCH SERVICES	
14	NONDISCRIMINATORY ACCESS TO ATTACH TO ELECTRIC	
15	INFRASTRUCTURE, OWNED OR CONTROLLED BY THE ELECTRIC	
16	COOPERATIVE CORPORATION, PURSUANT TO THE RATES, TERMS AND	
17	CONDITIONS COMPARABLE TO AND NO LESS FAVORABLE THAN THOSE	
18	OFFERED TO AN AFFILIATE OF AN ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE	
19	CORPORATION ENGAGED IN THE PROVISION OF RETAIL BROADBAND	
20	SERVICES.	
21	(b) ExceptionSubsection APPLICABILITY EXCEPT FOR THE	<
22	REPLACEMENT OR RELOCATION OF EXISTING POLES OR AS OTHERWISE	
23	PROVIDED BY LAW, SUBSECTION (a) (2) shall not apply to the	
24	attachment of broadband facilities that are additional	
25	freestanding or ground-based structures within the easement.	
26	(C) CONSTRUCTION EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED UNDER THIS	<
27	CHAPTER, NOTHING IN THIS CHAPTER SHALL LIMIT ANY OF THE RIGHTS	
28	THAT EXIST UNDER THE LAWS OF THIS COMMONWEALTH OF ANY BROADBAND	
29	SERVICE SUPPLIER TO SECURE ITS OWN EASEMENTS FOR THE	
30	CONSTRUCTION OR INSTALLATION OF BROADBAND FACILITIES OR THE	

- 1 PROVISION OF BROADBAND SERVICES.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
