AN ACT

- Amending Title 68 (Real and Personal Property) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for broadband services. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Title 68 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 7 Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read: 8 CHAPTER 82 9 BROADBAND SERVICES

- 13 § 8201. Definitions.
- 14 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 15 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- context clearly indicates otherwise: 16

- 1 "Affiliate." A person that directly, or indirectly through
- 2 one or more intermediaries, controls, is controlled by or is
- 3 under common control with a specified person. The term includes
- 4 <u>subsidiaries</u>, <u>partnerships</u>, <u>joint ventures and other entities</u>
- 5 that have shared resources, interests or business dealings.
- 6 "Broadband facilities." Wires, cables, materials, equipment
- 7 and other facilities, which are or can be used for the provision
- 8 <u>of broadband services.</u>
- 9 "Broadband service supplier." An electricity,
- 10 telecommunications, cable operator or Internet supplier or
- 11 affiliate that constructs, owns or installs new broadband
- 12 <u>facilities to provide broadband services</u>, at wholesale or
- 13 retail, using existing electric infrastructure, including, but
- 14 not limited to, poles and conduit, within an easement. The term
- 15 includes third parties with which the electric cooperative
- 16 <u>corporation contracts</u>, <u>licenses or otherwise enters into</u>
- 17 agreements with for the installation, service or maintenance of
- 18 broadband infrastructure and provision of broadband services on
- 19 behalf of the electric cooperative corporation or ITS affiliate.
- 20 "Broadband services." As follows:
- 21 (1) Service that consists of or includes the provision
- of broadband that:
- 23 (i) is used to provide access to the Internet; or
- 24 (ii) provides computer processing, information
- 25 storage, information content or protocol conversion.
- 26 (2) The term includes the provision of video services, <--
- 27 <u>voice over Internet protocol services, wireless services</u> and <--
- 28 Internet protocol-enabled services.
- 29 "Easement." A recorded or unrecorded right-of-way, easement
- 30 or similar property right acquired by eminent domain,

- 1 prescription or conveyance that is used or may be used for
- 2 transmitting, distributing or providing electric service by
- 3 <u>utilizing electric infrastructure.</u>
- 4 "Electric cooperative corporation." As defined in 15 Pa.C.S.
- 5 § 7302(a) (relating to application of chapter).
- 6 § 8202. Broadband services.
- 7 (a) Broadband facilities. -- The following apply:
- 8 (1) An electric cooperative corporation or an affiliate
- 9 <u>of an electric cooperative corporation may provide broadband</u>
- services or construct, operate and maintain broadband
- 11 <u>facilities through an existing easement owned, held or used</u>
- by the electric cooperative corporation. An electric
- 13 <u>cooperative corporation may only supply retail broadband</u>
- 14 <u>services through one or more affiliates.</u>
- 15 (2) Except as provided for under subsection (b), the
- 16 <u>attachment of broadband facilities shall not constitute a</u>
- change to the physical use of the easement, interfere with or
- impair any vested rights of the property owner subject to the
- 19 <u>easement or place an additional burden on the property or</u>
- 20 interests of the owner.
- 21 (3) A broadband service supplier that is not an electric
- 22 cooperative corporation may access and attach broadband
- 23 facilities within an electric cooperative corporation's
- 24 easement:
- 25 (i) if an electric cooperative corporation or its
- affiliates have attached broadband facilities to provide
- 27 <u>retail or wholesale broadband services or if an electric</u>
- 28 cooperative corporation, in its sole discretion, gives
- 29 <u>express written permission to a broadband service</u>
- 30 provider to utilize an existing electric easement; and

Τ	(11) subject to the terms of applicable safety
2	standards, the structural integrity of the electric
3	infrastructure and the electric cooperative corporation's
4	rules and fees for the attachments.
5	(4) An electric cooperative corporation that elects to
6	provide RETAIL broadband services, THROUGH AN AFFILIATE, as a <-
7	broadband service supplier shall permit other providers of
8	such services nondiscriminatory access to attach to electric
9	infrastructure, owned or controlled by the electric
10	cooperative corporation, pursuant to the rates, terms and
11	conditions comparable to and no less favorable than those
12	offered to an affiliate of an electric cooperative
13	corporation engaged in the provision of retail broadband
14	services. NOTHING IN THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL LIMIT, AMEND,
15	SUPERSEDE OR OTHERWISE ALTER THE RATES, TERMS AND CONDITIONS
16	ESTABLISHED UNDER EXISTING WRITTEN ATTACHMENT AGREEMENTS FOR
17	THE TERM OF SUCH AGREEMENTS EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER
18	SUBPARAGRAPH (III). THE FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY:
19	(I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (II), AN
20	ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION SHALL PROVIDE WRITTEN
21	NOTICE, BY FIRST CLASS MAIL, TO ANY BROADBAND SERVICE
22	SUPPLIER WITH WHICH IT HAS AN EXISTING WRITTEN AGREEMENT
23	GOVERNING THE BROADBAND SERVICE SUPPLIER'S ATTACHMENTS TO
24	ELECTRIC INFRASTRUCTURE OWNED OR CONTROLLED BY THE
25	ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION, WITHIN 90 DAYS OF THE
26	DATE ON WHICH AN ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION'S
27	AFFILIATE BEGINS OFFERING RETAIL BROADBAND SERVICES OVER
28	BROADBAND FACILITIES.
29	(II) AN ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION THAT IS
30	PROVIDING RETAIL BROADBAND SERVICE THROUGH AN AFFILIATE

1	AS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION SHALL NOT BE
2	REQUIRED TO SEND THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH
3	<u>(I).</u>
4	(III) FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS FROM RECEIPT OF THE
5	NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I), OR FROM THE
6	EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION IF SUBPARAGRAPH (II)
7	APPLIES, A BROADBAND SERVICE SUPPLIER THAT HAS AN
8	EXISTING WRITTEN ATTACHMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE ELECTRIC
9	COOPERATIVE CORPORATION SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO ATTACH TO
10	THE POLES OF THAT ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION AT
11	RATES THAT SHALL NOT EXCEED THE THEN-EFFECTIVE RATES IN
12	THE EXISTING AGREEMENT, SUBJECT TO PERMISSIBLE PERIODIC
13	RATE ADJUSTMENTS PROVIDED IN THE EXISTING AGREEMENT.
14	(5) AN ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION MAY NOT DO ANY
15	OF THE FOLLOWING:
16	(I) REQUIRE A PERSON TO PURCHASE BROADBAND SERVICES
17	FROM AN AFFILIATE OF THE ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION
18	AS A CONDITION OF RECEIVING OR CONTINUING TO RECEIVE
19	ELECTRIC ENERGY FROM THE ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE
20	CORPORATION; OR
21	(II) DISCONNECT, OR THREATEN TO DISCONNECT, ELECTRIC
22	SERVICE TO A CUSTOMER DUE TO THE CUSTOMER'S FAILURE TO
23	PAY FOR BROADBAND SERVICES PROVIDED TO THE CUSTOMER BY
24	THE ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION OR AN AFFILIATE.
25	(b) Applicability Except for the replacement or relocation
26	of existing poles or as otherwise provided by law, subsection
27	(a) (2) shall not apply to the attachment of broadband facilities
28	that are additional freestanding or ground-based structures
29	within the easement.
30	(C) CROSS-SUBSIDIZATIONTHE FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY:

1	(1) AN ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION THAT SUPPLIES
2	RETAIL BROADBAND SERVICES THROUGH AN AFFILIATE SHALL ENSURE
3	THAT THE RATES CHARGED FOR THE PROVISION OF ELECTRIC SERVICE
4	DO NOT INCLUDE ANY OF ITS AFFILIATE'S RETAIL BROADBAND
5	SERVICE COSTS AND SHALL NOT USE ITS ELECTRIC SERVICE REVENUES
6	TO SUBSIDIZE THE PROVISION OF RETAIL BROADBAND SERVICES TO
7	THE PUBLIC BY AN AFFILIATE.
8	(2) AN ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION MAY MAKE CAPITAL
9	INVESTMENTS IN AN AFFILIATE, MAKE LOANS FOR THE BENEFIT OF AN
10	AFFILIATE, ENTER INTO CAPITAL OR OPERATING LEASES WITH THE
11	AFFILIATE AND ENTER INTO GUARANTEES OR OTHER SECURITY
12	ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE AFFILIATE, ALL OF WHICH
13	MAY BE IN AMOUNTS, ON TERMS AND SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS AS THE
14	ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS
15	APPROVES AND DETERMINES TO BE PRUDENT OR APPROPRIATE.
16	(c) (D) ConstructionExcept as otherwise provided under <-
17	this chapter, nothing in this chapter shall limit any of the
18	rights that exist under the laws of this Commonwealth of any
19	broadband service supplier to secure its own easements for the
20	construction or installation of broadband facilities or the
21	provision of broadband services- OR TO NEGOTIATE SEPARATE TERMS <-
22	OR AGREEMENTS FOR ATTACHMENTS TO ELECTRIC INFRASTRUCTURE, OWNED
23	OR CONTROLLED BY AN ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION.
24	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
