No. 2475 Session of 2020

INTRODUCED BY SAYLOR, APRIL 30, 2020

AS RE-REPORTED FROM COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS, HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, AS AMENDED, MAY 26, 2020

AN ACT

1 Making appropriations from the restricted revenue accounts
2 within the State Gaming Fund and from the restricted revenue
3 accounts within the Fantasy Contest Fund and Video Gaming
4 Fund to the Attorney General, the Department of Revenue, the
5 Pennsylvania State Police and the Pennsylvania Gaming Control
6 Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, to June 30,
7 2021, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining
8 unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10 hereby enacts as follows:

12 PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

13 Section 101. Short title.

14 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Gaming
15 Control Appropriation Act of 2020.

16 PART III

17 STATE GAMING FUND

18 RESTRICTED REVENUE ACCOUNTS

19 Section 301. State Gaming Fund.

20 The following amounts set forth in this part, or as much
21 thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated from the

1 State Gaming Fund restricted revenue accounts under 4 Pa.C.S. §  
2 1401 (relating to slot machine licensee deposits) to the  
3 agencies of the Executive Department named in this part for the  
4 purposes set forth for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020,  
5 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at  
6 the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020.

7 Section 302. Attorney General.

8 The following amounts are appropriated to the  
9 Attorney General:

10 For salaries, wages and all necessary expenses  
11 of the Attorney General related to 4 Pa.C.S. Pt.  
12 II (relating to gaming).

6 Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board. This  
7 appropriation includes ~~\$5,000,000~~ \$6,000,000 from  
8 the restricted revenue account established in the  
9 State Gaming Fund for fees and other revenues  
10 collected by the board.

14 FANTASY CONTEST FUND

15 RESTRICTED REVENUE ACCOUNTS

16 Section 501. Fantasy Contest Fund.

17 The following amounts set forth in this part, or as much  
18 thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated from the  
19 Fantasy Contest Fund restricted revenue accounts under 4 Pa.C.S.  
20 § 332 (relating to licensed operator deposits) to the agencies  
21 of the Executive Department named in this part for the purposes  
22 set forth for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, and for  
23 payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of  
24 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020.

25 Section 502. Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board.

26 The following amounts are appropriated to the  
27 Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board:

28 For salaries, wages and all necessary expenses  
29 of the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board related  
30 to 4 Pa.C.S. Pt. I (relating to amusements

13 VIDEO GAMING FUND

14 RESTRICTED REVENUE ACCOUNTS

15 Section 701. Video Gaming Fund.

16 The following amounts set forth in this part, or as much  
17 thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated from the  
18 Video Gaming Fund restricted revenue accounts under 4 Pa.C.S. §  
19 4104 (relating to regulatory assessments) to the agencies of the  
20 Executive Department named in this part for the purposes set  
21 forth for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, and for  
22 payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of  
23 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020.

24 Section 702. Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board.

25 The following amounts are appropriated to the  
26 Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board:

27 For salaries, wages and all necessary expenses  
28 of the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board related  
29 to 4 Pa.C.S. Pt. II (relating to gaming).

10 PART IX

11 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

12 Section 901. Transfers prohibited.

13 There is no authority for the State Treasurer, the Secretary  
14 of the Budget, the Secretary of Revenue or the Pennsylvania  
15 Gaming Control Board to transfer any money within or between the  
16 appropriations in Parts III, V and VII.

17 Section 902. Effective date.

18 This act shall take effect July 1, 2020, or immediately,  
19 whichever is later.
