AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative 3 4 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 5 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 6 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; providing for judicial administration; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation 17 18 19 of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and commissions shall be 20 determined, "providing for emergency COVID-19 provisions. 21 22 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
