A SUPPLEMENT

Amending the act of October 15, 1980 (P.L.950, No.164), entitled "A supplement to the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct 3 of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth 4 by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative 6 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 11 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 14 15 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 17 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 19 20 commissions shall be determined, " implementing the addition 21 of section 4.1 to Article IV of the Constitution of 22 Pennsylvania; establishing the Office of Attorney General 23 elected by the citizens and setting forth powers and duties 24 25 of the Attorney General; creating an Office of General Counsel and providing for legal services for Commonwealth 26 27 agencies; transferring, reorganizing or reconstituting 28 certain boards, commissions and agencies; placing certain 29 duties upon the courts and district attorneys; repealing certain acts and parts of acts and making appropriations," in 30 Office of Attorney General, further providing for criminal 31 prosecutions. 32

- 2 Section 1. Section 205(a) of the act of October 15, 1980
- 3 (P.L.950, No.164), known as the Commonwealth Attorneys Act, is
- 4 amended by adding a paragraph and subsection (b) is amended to
- 5 read:
- 6 Section 205. Criminal prosecutions.
- 7 (a) Prosecutions. -- The Attorney General shall have the power
- 8 to prosecute in any county criminal court the following cases:
- 9 * * *
- 10 (6.1) Criminal charges, regardless of whether
- investigated and referred to him by a Commonwealth agency,
- 12 arising out of enforcement provisions of an environmental law
- or regulation.
- 14 * * *
- 15 (b) Concurrent jurisdiction to prosecute. -- The Attorney
- 16 General shall have the concurrent prosecutorial jurisdiction
- 17 with the district attorney for cases arising under subsection
- 18 (a) (1), (2), [and] (6) and (6.1) and may refer to the district
- 19 attorney with his consent any violation or alleged violation of
- 20 the criminal laws of the Commonwealth which may come to his
- 21 notice.

- 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
