- 1 Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania
 - Consolidated Statutes, in consolidated county assessment,
- further providing for regulations and training of boards.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 8852(a) of Title 53 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 8852. Regulations and training of boards.
- 9 (a) Regulations. -- Subject to the approval of the county
- 10 commissioners, the board may adopt, amend, alter and rescind
- 11 regulations for the administration of and the conduct of
- 12 business and proceedings for itself and for auxiliary appeal
- 13 boards. The regulations may require a witness providing
- 14 testimony at a hearing relative to any aspect of the value of
- 15 the real estate which is the subject of the assessment or
- 16 reassessment appeal to disclose, under oath, whether any
- 17 compensation paid for the testimony is contingent on the result
- 18 obtained. The regulations may not assess fees on applications

- 1 for appeals filed under section 8844(b) (relating to notices,
- 2 appeals and certification of values). The regulations shall be
- 3 in writing and shall be a public record open to examination,
- 4 inspection and copying in accordance with the act of February
- 5 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Right-to-Know Law.

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
