AN ACT

1 Amending Titles 65 (Public Officers) and 71 (State Government)
2 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in ethics
3 standards and financial disclosure, further providing for
4 restricted activities; and, in benefits, providing for
5 payment of benefits from the system to former members of
6 General Assembly.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 1103(g) of Title 65 of the Pennsylvania
10 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

11 § 1103. Restricted activities.

12 * * *

13 (g) Former official or employee.--

14 (1) No former public official or public employee shall
15 represent a person, with promised or actual compensation, on
16 any matter before the governmental body with which he has
17 been associated for one year after he leaves that body.

18 (2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a former
19 member of the General Assembly who represents a person, with
20 promised or actual compensation, in any matter before the

1 General Assembly may not receive pension benefits
2 administered by the State Employees' Retirement System or
3 health benefits administered by the Commonwealth during the
4 calendar year when the former member assists or acts in a
5 representative capacity before the General Assembly. This
6 paragraph shall only apply to former members of the General
7 Assembly first elected after the effective date of this
8 paragraph.

10 Section 2. Title 71 is amended by adding a section to read:
11 § 5711. Payment of benefits from the system to former members
12 of General Assembly.

13 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a former member
14 of the General Assembly who represents a person, with promised
15 or actual compensation, in any matter before the General
16 Assembly may not receive benefits from the system during the
17 calendar year when the former member assists or acts in a
18 representative capacity before the General Assembly. This
19 section shall only apply to former members of the General
20 Assembly first elected after the effective date of this
21 paragraph.

22 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
