AN ACT

- 1 Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 43267, on that
- portion of State Route 3041, also known as Dishong Mountain
- Road, over U.S. Route 22, also known as the William Penn
- 4 Highway, in Jackson Township, Cambria County, as the
- 5 Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial Bridge.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial Bridge.
- 9 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 10 follows:
- 11 (1) Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli was born in Nanty-
- 12 Glo, Pennsylvania, on May 15, 1918.
- 13 (2) He served in the United States Army during World War
- 14 II as part of Company I, 180th Infantry Regiment, 45th
- 15 Infantry Division.
- 16 (3) He was wounded many times and performed many acts of
- 17 heroism for which he was decorated during his tours of Italy,
- 18 Germany and France.
- 19 (4) On May 28, 1944, in Aprilia, Italy, Technical

- 1 Sergeant Mike Capelli's squad was impeded by the enemy's
- 2 machine guns. Technical Sergeant Capelli deployed his men and
- 3 led them in an assault on the enemy's position. Although
- 4 outnumbered and faced with intense fire, he succeeded after
- 5 fierce hand-to-hand fighting in destroying the enemy
- 6 position. For these actions, he was awarded an Oak Leaf
- 7 Cluster to his Silver Star Medal.
- 8 (5) On January 8, 1945, in Wildenguth, France, Technical
- 9 Sergeant Mike Capelli was shot and killed while organizing
- 10 his men during an attack by a reinforced band of German SS
- 11 Troopers.
- 12 (6) His awards include the Silver Star with Oak Leaf
- 13 Cluster, Bronze Star and Purple Heart with two Oak Leaf
- 14 Clusters.
- 15 (b) Designation. -- The bridge, identified as Bridge Key
- 16 43267, on that portion of State Route 3041, also known as
- 17 Dishong Mountain Road, over U.S. Route 22, also known as the
- 18 William Penn Highway, in Jackson Township, Cambria County, is
- 19 designated as the Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial
- 20 Bridge.
- 21 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 22 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 23 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 24 Section 2. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect in 60 days.
