Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study, 5 further providing for pandemic of 2020. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 1501.8(a) and (n) of the act of March 10, 9 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, 10 added March 27, 2020 (P.L.62, No.13), are amended and the 11 12 section is amended by adding a subsection to read: Section 1501.8. Pandemic of 2020.--(a) This section applies 13 14 only to the 2019-2020 school year as a result of the [global] 15 pandemic declared by the World Health Organization on March 11, 16 2020] pandemic of 2020. 17 18 (m.1) The following apply: (1) Notwithstanding subsection (a), this subsection applies 19

only to the 2020-2021 school year as a result of the pandemic of

- 4 <u>(relating to preparation program curriculum) for educator</u>
- 5 preparation programs that are unable to meet the regulatory
- 6 requirement due to the pandemic of 2020.
- 7 (n) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 8 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 9 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "NIMS assessment." An assessment based on the National
- 11 Institute for Metalworking Skills standards.
- 12 "NOCTI exam." A National Occupational Competency Testing
- 13 Institute exam.
- 14 "Pandemic of 2020." The global pandemic declared by the
- 15 World Health Organization on March 11, 2020.
- 16 "School entity." Any school district, intermediate unit,
- 17 area career and technical school, charter school, cyber charter
- 18 school or regional charter school a child attends in order to
- 19 fulfill the compulsory attendance requirements of this act.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
