## AN ACT

Amending the act of September 27, 1961 (P.L.1700, No.699), 1 entitled "An act relating to the regulation of the practice 2 of pharmacy, including the sales, use and distribution of 3 drugs and devices at retail; and amending, revising, consolidating and repealing certain laws relating thereto," further providing for definitions; and providing for pharmacy technician and pharmacy technician trainee registration, 6 qualifications and supervision. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of September 27, 1961 (P.L.1700, No.699), known as the Pharmacy Act, is amended by 12 13 adding clauses to read: 14 Section 2. Definitions. -- As used in this act: \* \* \* 15 16 (20) "Pharmacy technician" means an individual who: 17 (i) Is registered with the board as a pharmacy technician. 18 (ii) May assist in the practice of pharmacy under the direct 19 and immediate personal supervision of a licensed pharmacist

after meeting the requirements of this act and the regulations

- 2 (21) "Pharmacy technician trainee" means an individual who
- 3 has been issued a temporary permit by the board that authorizes
- 4 the individual to perform the duties of a pharmacy technician
- 5 <u>under the direct and immediate personal supervision of a</u>
- 6 <u>licensed pharmacist.</u>
- 7 (22) "Direct and immediate personal supervision" means:
- 8 (i) Review by the pharmacist of the prescription or drug
- 9 <u>order prior to dispensing.</u>
- 10 (ii) Verification by the pharmacist of the final product.
- 11 (iii) Immediate availability of the pharmacist on the
- 12 premises to direct the work of the supervised individual and to
- 13 <u>respond to questions or problems.</u>
- 14 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 15 <u>Section 3.3. Pharmacy Technician and Pharmacy Technician</u>
- 16 Trainee Registration, Qualifications and Supervision. -- (a) A
- 17 pharmacy technician shall register with the board biennially on
- 18 <u>a form prescribed by the board and pay a registration fee</u>
- 19 <u>established by the board by regulation. An individual must</u>
- 20 possess an unrestricted registration from the board to practice
- 21 as a pharmacy technician. The following shall apply:
- 22 (1) A pharmacy technician shall be responsible to and under
- 23 the direct and immediate personal supervision of a board-
- 24 <u>licensed pharmacist.</u>
- 25 (2) A registration for a pharmacy technician may not be
- 26 <u>issued if the applicant:</u>
- 27 (i) is unfit or unable to practice under section 3(a)(2); or
- 28 <u>(ii) has been convicted of an offense described under</u>
- 29 section 3(a)(6) in this Commonwealth or another state unless the
- 30 provisions of section 3(a)(6)(i), (ii) and (iii) have been

- 1 satisfied.
- 2 (3) An applicant for pharmacy technician registration shall
- 3 meet the following requirements:
- 4 (i) Be at least seventeen years of age and possess a high
- 5 <u>school diploma or equivalent.</u>
- 6 (ii) Complete a board-approved pharmacy technician training
- 7 program.
- 8 (iii) Submit to a criminal history record check as required
- 9 by the board.
- 10 (4) An individual practicing as a pharmacy technician for at
- 11 <u>least one year of the two-year period immediately preceding the</u>
- 12 <u>effective date of this section shall not be required to comply</u>
- 13 with clause (3)(i) or (ii), provided the individual applies
- 14 <u>within one year of the promulgation of regulations by the board</u>
- 15 <u>implementing this section</u>.
- 16 <u>(5) The board shall renew, refuse, revoke or suspend the</u>
- 17 registration of a pharmacy technician and temporary permit for a
- 18 pharmacy technician trainee, or otherwise discipline a pharmacy
- 19 technician and a pharmacy technician trainee, under regulations
- 20 promulgated by the board. This clause is subject to 2 Pa.C.S.
- 21 Chs. 5 Subch. A (relating to practice and procedure of
- 22 Commonwealth agencies) and 7 Subch. A (relating to judicial
- 23 review of Commonwealth agency action). Provisions and procedures
- 24 with respect to refusal and discipline contained in sections
- 25 <u>5(a), (c) and (d) and 7 shall apply to pharmacy technician</u>
- 26 registrations and pharmacy technician trainee permits.
- 27 <u>(6) Except as provided for in clause (7), or unless ordered</u>
- 28 to do so by a court of proper jurisdiction, the board may not
- 29 reinstate the registration of an individual whose registration
- 30 to practice as a pharmacy technician has been revoked or if the

- 1 individual is unfit or unable to practice under section 3(a)(2)
- 2 or has been convicted of an offense described under section 3(a)
- 3 <u>(6).</u>
- 4 (7) If an individual desires to practice after revocation,
- 5 the individual shall apply for registration after the lapse of a
- 6 <u>five-year period and in accordance with this section and</u>
- 7 <u>regulations</u>.
- 8 (8) A pharmacy technician shall wear a name tag that clearly
- 9 <u>identifies the pharmacy technician's first name with the title</u>
- 10 "Registered Pharmacy Technician."
- 11 (b) Upon the submission of a board-approved written
- 12 application and fee, the board may issue a temporary permit to
- 13 practice as a pharmacy technician trainee. The following shall
- 14 apply:
- 15 (1) A pharmacy technician trainee shall be responsible to
- 16 <u>and under the direct and immediate personal supervision of a</u>
- 17 board-licensed pharmacist.
- 18 (2) A registration for a pharmacy technician trainee may not
- 19 be issued if the applicant is unfit or unable to practice under
- 20 section 3(a)(2) or has been convicted of an offense described
- 21 under section 3(a)(6) in this Commonwealth or another state
- 22 unless the provisions of section 3(a)(6)(i), (ii) and (iii) have
- 23 been satisfied.
- 24 (3) An applicant for pharmacy technician trainee
- 25 <u>registration shall meet the following requirements:</u>
- 26 (i) Be at least sixteen years of age.
- 27 (ii) Submit to a criminal history record check as required
- 28 by the board.
- 29 (4) The board shall issue only one temporary permit to an
- 30 applicant and the temporary permit shall expire two years after

- 1 the date of issue or upon obtaining registration as a pharmacy
- 2 technician under subsection (a).
- 3 (5) Upon expiration of the temporary permit, the applicant
- 4 shall promptly return the permit to the board.
- 5 (6) A pharmacy technician trainee shall wear a name tag that
- 6 clearly identifies the pharmacy technician trainee's first name
- 7 with the title "Pharmacy Technician Trainee."
- 8 Section 3. No individual is required to register as a
- 9 pharmacy technician under section 3.3 of the act until one year
- 10 after the State Board of Pharmacy has promulgated final
- 11 regulations.
- 12 Section 4. Within 18 months of the effective date of this
- 13 act, the State Board of Pharmacy shall promulgate final
- 14 regulations to implement this act.
- 15 Section 5. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
