A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing February 4, 2018, as "National Thank a Mail Carrier Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, On July 26, 1775, the Second Continental Congress
- 4 established the United States postal system; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Benjamin Franklin served as the nation's first
- 6 postmaster general and put in place the foundation for many
- 7 aspects of the modern mail system; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Today the United States Postal Service has more than
- 9 40,000 post offices that deliver over 145 billion pieces of mail
- 10 every year to more than 144 million homes, businesses and
- 11 organizations throughout the United States; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The postal service is among the largest civilian
- 13 employers in the United States with more than 700,000 employees
- 14 who handle more than 44% of the world's cards and letters; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The motto "Neither snow nor rain nor heat nor gloom
- 16 of night stays these couriers from the swift completion of their

- 1 appointed round" is often attributed to the United States Postal
- 2 Service, signifying the dedication mail carriers have to their
- 3 work; and
- 4 WHEREAS, "National Thank a Mail Carrier Day" is observed
- 5 annually on February 4, serving as a reminder of the important
- 6 role that mail carriers play in the United States; therefore be
- 7 it
- 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize
- 9 February 4, 2018, as "National Thank a Mail Carrier Day" in
- 10 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives celebrate the
- 12 important work that mail carriers do throughout this
- 13 Commonwealth and the nation.
