A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of February 3 through 9, 2019, as "National
2 Future Business Leaders of America-Phi Beta Lambda Week" in
3 Pennsylvania.

4 WHEREAS, Future Business Leaders of America-Phi Beta Lambda
5 (FBLA-PBL) is a nonprofit educational organization whose first
6 chapter was established in Johnson City, Tennessee, in 1942; and

7 WHEREAS, This organization has grown to encompass over
8 230,000 members and advisers nationwide in middle schools, high
9 schools, colleges, universities, career and technical schools
10 and private business schools; and

11 WHEREAS, FBLA-PBL inspires and prepares students to become
12 community-minded business leaders in a global society through
13 relevant career preparation and leadership experiences; and

14 WHEREAS, Members perform community service activities and
15 strive to build a student's understanding of the realities of
16 the modern business world; and

17 WHEREAS, FBLA teaches high school students basic business and

2 technical and business school students to make the transition
