A RESOLUTION

1 Designating May 1, 2019, as "Law Day" in Pennsylvania and urging  
2 lawmakers, attorneys, judges and schools to participate in  
3 this year's celebration.

4 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Bar Association is launching its  
5 19th annual "Law Day" program on May 1, 2019; and

6 WHEREAS, As part of the celebration, the Pennsylvania Bar  
7 Association and local bar associations across this Commonwealth  
8 are sponsoring activities throughout the month of May; and

9 WHEREAS, The theme for 2019 is "Free Speech, Free Press, Free  
10 Society"; and

11 WHEREAS, The celebration is coordinated by the Law-Related  
12 Education Committee of the Pennsylvania Bar Association and  
13 funded by the Pennsylvania Bar Foundation; and

14 WHEREAS, Schools, attorneys and judges are encouraged to work  
15 together to arrange for classroom visits as part of the  
16 celebration; and

1       WHEREAS, The primary purpose of the celebration is to teach  
2 children about their legal rights and responsibilities and to  
3 share with them the essence of being an American citizen; and

4       WHEREAS, Students of all ages, from kindergarten through  
5 college, will have the opportunity to explore the ways in which  
6 they can have an impact on our world; therefore be it

7       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate May 1,  
8 2019, as "Law Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it further

9       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge all  
10 lawmakers, attorneys, judges and schools to participate in this  
11 year's celebration.
