A RESOLUTION

- Recommending the Department of Corrections provide
- identification badges for corrections officers.
- 3 WHEREAS, Corrections officers encounter safety risks on a
- daily basis while overseeing inmates in Department of
- 5 Corrections facilities; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Corrections officers encounter safety risks while
- 7 working to reduce criminal behavior in our communities; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Without regard for their safety and often without
- adequate identification, corrections officers stop bank
- 10 robberies, rescue children from burning houses and assist local
- 11 police in capturing suspects at large; and
- 12 WHEREAS, As essential employees, corrections officers require
- 13 access despite road and facility closures during a state of
- 14 emergency; and
- 15 WHEREAS, There is no standard identification badge to quickly
- 16 convey an individual's status as a corrections officer to
- 17 emergency services providers, law enforcement personnel or
- certain other corrections officers; and 18

- 1 WHEREAS, An appropriate identification badge indicating an
- 2 individual's status as a corrections officer would protect an
- 3 officer who intervenes in a criminal or noncriminal incident or
- 4 an emergency situation; and
- 5 WHEREAS, An appropriate identification badge indicating an
- 6 individual's status as a corrections officer would establish an
- 7 officer's credentials for travel or access as needed; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Thirty-two states provide identification badges to
- 9 corrections officers; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Department of Corrections identification badges
- 11 would facilitate the preparedness and professional conduct of
- 12 corrections officers and ensure their safety in the face of
- 13 dangers in the workplace, at crime scenes and at emergency
- 14 scenes; therefore be it
- 15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recommend the
- 16 Department of Corrections provide identification badges for
- 17 corrections officers.
