A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating April 14, 2019, as "Sikh Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 2 WHEREAS, The cultural and intellectual diversity of the
- 3 Commonwealth is a source of strength and inspiration for its
- 4 people; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The Sikh community continues to play an integral,
- 6 though often overlooked, role in strengthening the religious,
- 7 social and political fabric of this Commonwealth; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Sikhism is the world's fifth largest religion with
- 9 nearly 30 million adherents, roughly 500,000 of whom call the
- 10 United States home; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Founded by Guru Nanak in the Punjab region of India
- 12 during the 15th century, the Sikh spiritual tradition is rooted
- 13 in the belief that every person, regardless of race, gender, sex
- 14 or creed, is equal before God; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The basic principles of the Sikh religion include
- 16 social, gender and human equality, along with sharing and caring
- 17 for others and defending the weak; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Believing that every person shares a connection
- 2 through the oneness of God, the Sikh community emerged as a
- 3 force for social justice by encouraging female participation in
- 4 religious services and initiating interfaith efforts to combat
- 5 oppression and injustice; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The religion's central principles of truthful
- 7 living, service to humanity, and devotion to God also inspire
- 8 its believers to create inclusive communities where all are
- 9 respected; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Through leading charitable events, the Sikh
- 11 community embodies the sense of public service that underlies
- 12 this country's founding principles; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The people of Pennsylvania honor the Sikh
- 14 community's important role in supporting and enriching the
- 15 social fabric of this Commonwealth; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Sikhs celebrate Vaisakhi on the first day of the
- 17 month of Vaisakh in the Sikh calendar, which typically falls on
- 18 April 14th; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Vaisakhi is a special occasion in which Sikhs
- 20 remember the founding in 1699 of the Khalsa Panth, a fellowship
- 21 of devout saint soldiers, which played an important role in
- 22 shaping the religion's history and identity; and
- 23 WHEREAS, It is fitting and proper for the people of
- 24 Pennsylvania to celebrate the day of Vaisakhi alongside Sikhs
- 25 throughout the world and to honor the lasting contributions made
- 26 by the Sikh community in this Commonwealth; therefore be it
- 27 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate April
- 28 14, 2019, as "Sikh Day" in Pennsylvania.
