A RESOLUTION

- Paying tribute to those who lost their lives during the terrorist attack at the mosques in Christchurch, New Zealand.
- WHEREAS, At approximately 1:40 p.m. on Friday, March 15,
- 4 2019, a gunman entered a Christchurch, New Zealand city mosque
- 5 with a semi-automatic weapon and opened fire on people inside
- 6 during Jumu'ah prayer; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The gunman then proceeded to a second mosque and
- 8 continued on his murderous rampage; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The gunman shot and killed a total of 50 people and
- 10 seriously injured 50 others; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The attack is New Zealand's worst terror attack and
- 12 deadliest mass shooting and incident of violence against the
- 13 Muslim community in its history; and
- 14 WHEREAS, New Zealand Prime Minister Jacinda Ardern described

- 1 the horror as a terrorist attack, saying it was perpetrated by
- 2 suspects with "extremist views" that had no place in her country
- 3 or the wider world; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Stories of the bravery of those inside the mosques
- 5 have revealed that some acted as heroes in an attempt to shield
- 6 family members and fellow worshipers, with one worshiper
- 7 actually chasing the gunman away from the first mosque, thus
- 8 preventing further loss of life; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The terrorist attack appeared to have been carried
- 10 out by a white nationalist who posted a racist manifesto online
- 11 and streamed live video of the killings; and
- 12 WHEREAS, A 28-year-old man from Australia was charged with
- 13 murder, and New Zealand police have said he would face
- 14 additional charges and were considering charging him under the
- 15 country's Terrorism Suppression Act 2002; and
- 16 WHEREAS, With an immense outpouring of support from all over
- 17 the world, people have shown they value the lives and
- 18 contributions of those of all religions and advocate love and
- 19 acceptance over hate and ignorance; and
- 20 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of
- 21 Pennsylvania denounces the killing of innocent people and the
- 22 use of violence to express hate and inflict terror; therefore be
- 23 it
- 24 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 25 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania pay tribute to those who lost their
- 26 lives during the terrorist attack at the mosques in
- 27 Christchurch, New Zealand; and be it further
- 28 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 29 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania extend its deepest condolences to
- 30 the families and friends of the victims; and be it further

- 1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 2 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania acknowledge the efforts of the
- 3 emergency responders and law enforcement officers who risked
- 4 their lives to protect their community as well as all those who
- 5 sought to help victims during and after the shootings; and be it
- 6 further
- 7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 8 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania express its strong support for the
- 9 survivors of the terrorist attack as well as all the residents
- 10 of Christchurch, New Zealand in their recovery and healing; and
- 11 be it further
- 12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 13 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania commit to doing what it can to
- 14 combat the proliferation of hate, terror and violence in our
- 15 communities and in our Commonwealth; and be it further
- 16 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to

- 18 Auckland, New Zealand.
