INTRODUCED AS NONCONTROVERSIAL RESOLUTION UNDER RULE 35, MAY 1, 2019

A RESOLUTION

- Designating May 8, 2019, as "Tuskegee Airmen Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, During World War I, African Americans were
- 4 prohibited from serving as military pilots in the United States
- 5 Armed Forces due to their race; and
- 6 WHEREAS, In 1939, in response to advocacy by civil rights
- 7 leaders and the National Association for the Advancement of
- 8 Colored People, the Congress of the United States approved
- 9 funding designated for the training of African-American military
- 10 pilots; and
- 11 WHEREAS, On March 22, 1941, the United States Army Air Corps
- 12 99th Pursuit Squadron was activated to become the first African-
- 13 American fighter squadron; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The members of the 99th Pursuit Squadron were the
- 15 first to be known as Tuskegee Airmen because they had received

- 1 their initial flight training at Moton Field, a segregated air
- 2 base in Tuskegee, Alabama; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Other Tuskegee Airmen would later form the famous
- 4 332nd Fighter Group, also known as the "Red Tails" due to the
- 5 distinctive red marking on the tail of their aircraft; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Between 1941 and 1946, nearly 1,000 African-American
- 7 military pilots were trained in Tuskegee, Alabama; and
- 8 WHEREAS, During World War II, the Tuskegee Airmen flew more
- 9 than 15,000 sorties and lost 66 men in the line of duty, one of
- 10 the lowest loss records of any escort fighter group; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The courage, dedication and service of the Tuskegee
- 12 Airmen men and women continues to inspire both military
- 13 personnel and civilians of all backgrounds throughout this
- 14 country; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate May 8,
- 16 2019, as "Tuskegee Airmen Day" in Pennsylvania.
