A RESOLUTION

1 Designating May 6 through 12, 2019, as "Fallen Firefighters
2 Survivors' Week" in Pennsylvania and May 8, 2019, as "Fallen
3 Firefighters Survivors' Day" in Pennsylvania.

4 WHEREAS, Firefighters, whether volunteer or career, bravely
5 serve the people of this Commonwealth every day; and

6 WHEREAS, Thousands of firefighters in this Commonwealth risk
7 their lives with each emergency call they respond to while on
8 duty; and

9 WHEREAS, Tragically, not all firefighters who respond to
10 emergency calls make it back to their fire stations alive; and

11 WHEREAS, Each fallen firefighter leaves behind family and
12 other loved ones as well as fellow firefighters; and

13 WHEREAS, The National Fallen Firefighters Foundation (NFFF)
14 was created by the Congress of the United States in 1992 to lead

1 a nationwide effort to remember America's fallen firefighters;
2 and

3 WHEREAS, Since that time, the NFFF has developed and expanded
4 programs to honor our fallen heroes and remember their families
5 and coworkers; and

6 WHEREAS, The NFFF also provides resources to assist the
7 survivors of fallen firefighters and works within the fire
8 service community to reduce firefighter injuries and death; and

9 WHEREAS, The NFFF receives no direct Federal funding, but
10 instead relies on grants, individual and corporate donations and
11 fundraising events; and

12 WHEREAS, Because firefighters are constantly available to
13 serve this Commonwealth, it is fitting that we honor the
14 firefighting community whenever possible and recognize the
15 survivors of fallen firefighters; therefore be it

16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate May 6
17 through 12, 2019, as "Fallen Firefighters Survivors' Week" in
18 Pennsylvania; and be it further

19 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate May 8,
20 2019, as "Fallen Firefighters Survivors' Day" in Pennsylvania.
