- Recognizing the week of September 22 through 28, 2019, as "National Adult Education and Family Literacy Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 4 WHEREAS, The literacy of the residents of Pennsylvania is
- 5 essential for their economic well-being and for the prosperity
- 6 of this Commonwealth; and
- WHEREAS, Without literacy skills, an individual's ability to
- 8 complete high school or an equivalency program, continue on to a
- 9 postsecondary degree or complete a job training program is
- 10 negatively impacted; and
- 11 WHEREAS, A lack of literacy skills increases the chance of
- 12 unemployment or underemployment, potentially impeding an
- 13 individual's ability to provide for his or her family; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Literacy among adults is key to ensuring the
- 15 educational success of future generations, with research showing
- 16 that reading to children by adults has a direct impact on

- 1 children's academic achievement; and
- 2 WHEREAS, According to the National Center for Education
- 3 Statistics, approximately 13% of adults in Pennsylvania lack the
- 4 basic literacy skills to read and follow medical instructions,
- 5 placing the health of affected individuals and their families at
- 6 risk; and
- 7 WHEREAS, "National Adult Education and Family Literacy Week"
- 8 highlights the need to support literacy initiatives and ensure
- 9 that everyone has the necessary literacy skills to succeed at
- 10 home, at work and in society; and
- 11 WHEREAS, "National Adult Education and Family Literacy Week"
- 12 is being celebrated from September 22 through 28, 2019;
- 13 therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 15 week of September 22 through 28, 2019, as "National Adult
- 16 Education and Family Literacy Week" in Pennsylvania.
