A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the month of October 2019 as "National Arts and
2 Humanities Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The arts and humanities embody much of the
4 accumulated wisdom, intellect and imagination of humankind; and

5 WHEREAS, The arts and humanities enhance and enrich the lives
6 of every American; and

7 WHEREAS, The arts and humanities play a unique role in the
8 lives of our families, communities and country; and

9 WHEREAS, The nonprofit arts industry strengthens
10 Pennsylvania's economy by generating \$3.4 billion in total
11 economic activity annually, \$402 million in government revenue
12 and by supporting the full-time equivalent of 100,114 jobs; and

13 WHEREAS, The month of October has been recognized as
14 "National Arts and Humanities Month" by thousands of arts and
15 cultural organizations, communities and states across the

1 country, as well as the White House and the Congress of the
2 United States for 30 years; therefore be it

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
4 month of October 2019 as "National Arts and Humanities Month" in
5 Pennsylvania; and be it further

6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives call upon
7 residents of this Commonwealth to celebrate and promote arts and
8 culture and encourage residents to take action for the arts and
9 humanities in their towns and cities.
